 - At least one letter of recommendation from a high school guidance counselor or teacher.

 - A \$40 non-refundable application fee payable by personal check, money order or cashier's check to Trinity. The application fee is waived for students who visit campus.

 - SAT/ACT scores are highly recommended. **Trinity's SAT Code is 5796; Trinity's ACT Code is 0696.**

TRANSFER APPLICANTS

In addition to the above, please submit transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended. If you have earned fewer than 24 credit hours, you must submit official high school transcripts.

RETURNING STUDENTS

If you have been away from Trinity for more than two academic years, you must submit a completed, signed and dated application for re-admission, a \$40 non-refundable application fee and official transcripts from any school attended after leaving Trinity. **Please call the Office of Admissions for a copy of the application for readmission.**

ROLLING ADMISSIONS

Trinity accepts applications to all programs on a rolling basis. The Office of Admissions evaluates an application once all supporting materials have been received. Applicants will be notified of admissions decisions within 2-3 weeks of receipt of a complete application.

FINANCIAL AID APPLICANTS

If you wish to be considered for state and/or federal financial aid (including student loans), you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Do not wait until you are admitted to apply for financial aid. Although Trinity does not consider financial need as a factor in the admissions process, we do encourage applicants to file the FAFSA as soon as possible after January 1 of the year you intend to enroll. March 1 is the Financial Aid Priority Deadline. You must submit your FAFSA to the Federal Processing Center by March 1 in order to receive maximum consideration for aid. **Trinity's FAFSA code is 001460.**

HONORS PROGRAM

The Trinity Honors Program provides academically motivated students with the intellectual stimulation that comes from small, seminar-style classes and intensive debate and discussion with their peers and professors. The Honors Program places special emphasis on superior academic achievement, self-knowledge, intellectual risk-taking and professional development.

DEADLINES

Fall Semester Applicants

- January 15:** **Priority Deadline for first year applicants.** If you apply on or before this date, you will receive maximum consideration for admissions and merit-based scholarships.
- March 1:** **Financial Aid Priority Deadline.** If you submit your FAFSA to the Federal Processing Center on or before this date, you will receive the highest consideration for federal financial aid.
- July 1:** **Priority Deadline for transfer applicants.**

Spring Semester Applicants

- December 1:** **Priority deadline for first year and transfer students** interested in starting at Trinity in the Spring semester. If you apply on or before this date, you will receive maximum consideration for admissions and merit-based scholarships.
