For both men and women, Trinity College offers inexpensive, clean, and comfortable housing in air-conditioned residence halls for visiting college and university students residing in the Washington, D.C. area.

Trinity College is located in a northeast residential area of Washington, easily accessible by Metrobus and Metrorail. In addition, the College offers complimentary shuttle van service between the campus and the Brookland/CUA Metrorail station at regularly scheduled times. Free on-campus parking is also provided. Adjacent to the 26 acre campus is a shopping center with a convenience store and bank. Dining Hall meal service is available during most times of the year for a modest cost. Payment in full for the entire length of stay must be received by the Conference/Housing Office at least five (5) days prior to scheduled arrival date. If you are entitled to paying a weekly rate, a payment of a refundable room deposit (\$150) plus one week's stay is required five (5) days prior to scheduled arrival date. Each week's payment will be due on a pre-determined day for the duration of your stay. Weekly payments must be paid on-time each week and handed to the Conference Director no later than 5pm on the pre-determined day. Failure to comply with these rules will result in a loss of accommodations.

The charge for replacing lost and/or unreturned room keys are \$50. Loss of a dormitory entrance key will result in a fee of \$75. Keys should be returned at the time of departure to the Conference Office (located on the 4th floor of the Main Administration Building) or Campus Dispatch (located on the basement level of the Main Administration Building).

Checks should be made payable to Trinity College and directed to the attention of the Conference Services & Events Office for processing. Payment may also be made over the phone with VISA or MASTERCARD by calling (202) 884-9136.

Any vehicle on campus must be registered with the Trinity College campus safety office. A Trinity College parking permit must be displayed on all vehicles. Individuals residing on campus are subject to all Trinity College rules, regulations, and Residence Life policies.

This form is only an application. After housing availability is determined, applicants will be notified by mail. A Housing Agreement must be signed prior to or upon check-in.
